

Northern Arizona






Northern Arizona is home to numerous native American tribes. Navajo, Hopi, Havasupai, Hualipai and Kaibab-Pauite are most prominent. By far the largest of all five reservations, the Navajo Nation, created in 1868, has a population of over 250,000 and is more than 18,000 square miles, extending into Utah and New Mexico.

The Town of **Cottonwood** is surrounded by jagged mountains on the south and west and to the north and east by mesas and buttes. Named for the beautiful Cottonwood trees that grow along the Verde River, the town grew from a small farming community to the Verde Valley's population center, called "the biggest little town in Arizona" by the late 1920s. At that time Old Town businesses supported residents and workers of the many mines that operated in nearby communities.

Located just minutes from Sedona, Jerome and Clarkdale, Old Town Cottonwood is ideally situated near the Verde River offering a variety of recreational activities that include camping, horseback riding and fishing. Historic Old Town on Main Street is home to a number of LGBTQ owned and friendly antique shops, fine dining, wine bars and art galleries, plus a multitude of wineries and vineyards, Dead Horse Ranch State

Clarkdale is a town in the heart of the Verde Valley, only 10 minutes from Jerome and 30 minutes from Sedona. The Verde River flows through the town as does Bitter Creek, an intermittent tributary of the river.

Hop aboard the Verde Canyon Railroad for the longest running nature show along the Verde River. Spot bald eagles and enjoy an array of special events onboard throughout the year. Experience the Arizona Copper Art Museum housed in the restored Clarkdale High School with its dazzling array of thousands of gorgeous copper artifacts (some of which you can touch). Float the Verde River with experienced local river outfitters and enjoy unspoiled riparian areas adjacent to the Audubon














A college town, a mountain town, a town filled with history and charm. Skiing, hiking, museums, astronomy, festivals; this is what Flagstaff has to offer. Adjacent to the towering 12,633 foot tall San Francisco Peaks, Flagstaff is surrounded by Ponderosa Pine trees, lies at an elevation of about 7,000 feet and is nestled along historic Route 66.

Home to Northern Arizona University (NAU), the college atmosphere brings a wonderful eclectic mix of coffee houses, bookstores, shopping, restaurants and eateries to the area.

In this lovely small mountain community, you'll find yourself surrounded by the 1.8 million acre Coconino National Forest. A hiker's delight, you'll find a wonderland LGBTQ travelers will be happy to know that each year the Northern Arizona Pride Association sponsors Pride in the Pines, an annual pride festival. The June event brings in guests from all over the state.

#### GRAND CANYON

A National Park since 1919, attracting more than five million visitors yearly, the **Grand Canyon** is the most visited National Park in the United States.

The park is home to numerous animals such as the California condor, mountain lions, cougars, rattlesnakes, elk, bald and golden eagles, bighorn sheep, and over 1,500 species of plants. It is one of the most complete archaeological sites dating back thousands of years. Sustaining these plant

and animal communities, as well as carving the Canyon, is the powerful Colorado River, the lifeblood of the desert southwest.


The Hualapai (WALL-uh-pie) tribe, the "People of the Tall Pines," located on the far west end of the Grand Canyon, opened a breathtaking skywalk over the canyon in 2007.

The Grand Canyon can be toured by foot, mule, water or by train. Visitors will not be disappointed with any method they choose.

#### JEROME

The old mining town with its coppery glowing hillsides is often dubbed the "Largest Ghost Town in America." It's a town that just won't die. Jerome began as an old copper mining camp that grew from a settlement of tents into a roaring mining community. Four disastrous fires destroyed large sections of the town during its early history, resulting in the incorporation of the City of Jerome in 1899.





Once the fourth-most prominent city in the Arizona Territory, the population peaked at 15,000 in the 1920's. Jerome's population today boasts 455 which includes artists, craft people, musicians, writers, hermits, bed and breakfast owners, museum caretakers, gift shop proprietors and perhaps an old prospector or two.

#### KINGMAN

The Heart of Historic Route 66 & one of the hidden treasures of Arizona, is conveniently located on Interstate 40 and is the perfect launching point for "Route 66 and Beyond." Scenic hiking, historic charm, great cafes and restaurants, and the allure of Route 66 combine to make Kingman a remarkable destination. The roots of Arizona are captured by the Historic Route 66 Museum, Army Airfield Museum and the Mohave Museum of History and Arts. At an elevation

of around 3,300 feet Kingman offers a temperate climate year-round. Take a 70-mile journey to enjoy the Skywalk at the Grand Canyon West and many other fabulous day trips... returning to the relaxing accommodations in Kingman at the end of the day.

#### LAKE HAVASU CITY

There is nothing more amazing than the contrast of the arid Arizona desert and the cool, refreshing, rapid Colorado River. Along Arizona's border, stretching more than 300 miles from Nevada to Mexico, the Colorado unfolds in a sapphire blue lake teeming with fish and surrounded by an abundance of wildlife. Nowhere is this convergence of land and water more spectacular than in the center of it all, **Lake Havasu**.

Rising effortlessly from the shore and set against the scenic backdrop of the Sonoran and Mojave deserts, Lake Havasu City and its surroundings take many forms: sand swept dunes, hidden canyons, and breathtaking rock formations among them, and offers everything from lake and desert tours to golf, tennis, shopping, dining, to a full range of water-sports activities.

#### PAGE

Your mecca for hiking, biking, boating and off-road adventure. A short seven miles from the water sports playground of Lake Powell, Page is your ideal base for exploring this exceptional region. Hike the striking wind and water carved beauty of Antelope Canyon. Set out on your Colorado River rafting trip. Take in the dramatic vistas of Lake Powell and Glen Canyon Dam. Located beside Navajo Tribal lands, Page is rich in geographic, cultural and historic marvels to explore.

#### PRESCOTT

Take a step back to the old Southwest. Redolent of the past, the town's architecture still holds onto the secrets of the days gone by. Prescott, pronounced "PRES-kit" in the way that rhymes with "biscuit"... any local will surely let you know it. Prescott's allure is its beautiful downtown area called Courthouse Plaza, surrounded by a lovely grassy square. Prescott is filled with many historic buildings and areas. Fort Whipple, a former military base now serves as a medical facility. Prescott is also home to the Hassayampa Inn, the Sharlot Hall Museum and "Whiskey Row" a notorious red-light district until 1956.

#### **S**EDONA

Filled with wide-open spaces for mountain biking, hiking and offroading adventures, **Sedona** has it all! Visit a state park, play golf, take a scenic drive or visit a winery. Sedona boasts art galleries, musical and theatrical performances, spiritual and personal enrichment activities, annual festivals and many community events.

All this with a backdrop of some of the most spectacular scenery in the world. Sedona is called "Red Rock Country" for good reason. Everywhere you look it is filled with spectacular views of picturesque red rock formations with colorful names: Coffeepot, Cathedral Rock, Thunder Mountain, Steam Boat Rock, Courthouse Butte and more.

Phoenix Metro is comprised of various towns and cities. Tempe, Chandler, Mesa, Gilbert, and Apache Junction are in the East Valley. Glendale, Avondale, Peoria, Goodyear, Sun City, and Buckeye are in the West Valley. Scottsdale and Fountain Hills are Northeast Valley communities and the state capital, Phoenix proper, lies in the center of it all. Phoenix Metro enjoys some of the easiest navigation in comparison to other major cities.

The extensive freeway system and our grid-oriented cities makes navigating the streets of Phoenix a breeze. The Valley Metro Light Rail currently connects Central Mesa to Central Phoenix. With over 40 miles of Light Rail scheduled to be completed by 2030, 20,000 jobs will be created to build and maintain the Light Rail system.

#### **PHOENIX**

The Capital of the state of Arizona, **Phoenix**, is its largest city, with over 1.7 million residents. Being so extensive Phoenix offers something for every type of lifestyle, from the urban life of Downtown and the Central Corridor, to the suburban, desert life of the Ahwatukee Foothills in the southern part of the city.

Phoenix recently ranked eighth in the nation as one of the most inexpensive cities to live, work and own a business. Its cost of living estimates are below that of Las Vegas, San Diego, and Seattle.

With the addition of the Valley Metro Light Rail, Downtown Phoenix has seen resurgence in life. Many new modern housing units as well as cafés, coffee shops, restaurants, bars, and nightclubs have popped up along the route, which passes right through Central Phoenix.

Phoenix's cultural scene is also increasing in popularity. Phoenix plays host to various different national and international art exhibits throughout the year in its museums. Phoenix's various theaters and performing arts centers feature local productions as well as internationally traveling dance companies and shows year round.

A valley institution, the Biltmore Fashion Park and the surrounding area, is home to internationally renowned luxury brands as well as much of Phoenix's fine dining. #### MELROSE DISTRICT

Unlike some other major metropolitan areas, Phoenix does not have a central LGBTQ neighborhood. As Phoenix is so geographically spread out, most LGBTO Phoenicians are too. However, the Melrose District of Central Phoenix has a high concentration of diverse residents as well as inclusive businesses. Many bars and nightclubs are situated in this area. The Phoenix LGBTO area stretches north from Roosevelt Street to Northern Avenue and West from 16th Street to 15th Avenue. Additional LGBTO businesses can also be found scattered throughout the Valley.

Established by Army Chaplain Winfield Scott, Scottsdale has, since its beginning, been a haven for cowboys as well as the social elite. Many of the original settlers of Scottsdale, recruited by Scott from the east coast, were well-educated and had a great appreciation for cultural events. In 1937, Frank Lloyd Wright purchased 600 acres of Sonoran Desert land and built Taliesin West, his winter home and architectural firm/school's southwestern headquarters. Throughout the 1950's, greatly under the guidance of Del Webb, Scottsdale became an upscale getaway, with luxury resorts attracting movie stars and prominent public figures.

Mesa is Arizona's third largest city and one of the fastest growing cities in the state. Historically, Arizona has been home to countless citrus groves. Mesa has found a way to incorporate many of the existing orchards into commercial and residential developments, thus preserving the history and natural beauty of the area.

Tempe is home to Arizona State University as well as Mill Avenue, a main drag and Tempe's downtown, featuring shopping, restaurants, and a lively nightlife frequented by ASU's more than 50,000 students. ASU is also home to Gammage Auditorium, an opera house designed by Frank Lloyd Wright, originally proposed for Baghdad, Iraq. It is now a multi-functional performing arts facility that hosts Off-Broadway productions as well as various other performances.

Tempe is also one of the state's most dynamic business communities, with more than 15 percent of the state's high-tech companies located there.

### FOUNTAIN HILLS & CAREFREE

The desert communities of Fountain Hills and Carefree offer some of the most beautiful views of the Valley's desert landscape. The town of Fountain Hills, located about 30 minutes northeast of downtown Phoenix on the eastern slope of the McDowell Mountains and about 500 feet above the Valley, is home to over 22,000 residents and one very conspicuous landmark. Situated in the middle of a lake in Fountain Park, is a fountain that shoots a plume of water an amazing 560 feet into the air.

The town of Carefree is located 15 miles northeast of Phoenix and is noted for its artisan population and cooler temperatures. The Carefree town motto is "home of cowboys and caviar, where the old west meets the new" and boasts the best of small town Arizona. Its population is less than 4,000, but growing.

The West Valley has gone through a major makeover in recent years. Agriculture has made way for residential communities that are thriving as the Valley continues to spread out. Avondale has ambitious development plans and the smaller city of Buckeye plans over 250,000 new homes in the next 20 years. Nearby Peoria is a model of the fast-growing Arizona city, with a stellar school system, affordable homes, and accessibility to the rest of the Valley.

Arizona's sixth largest city is **Glendale**, a rapidly growing financial and business hub in the Northwest Valley. Glendale is a mix of older communities and new, masterplanned developments. In 2023, Glendale will host the NFL Super Bowl at State Farm® Stadium. The state of the art facility, designed by architect Peter Eisenman, boasts the first retractable, natural grass field in North America and permanent seating for approximately 63,400. It is truly a must see for anyone visiting or relocating to the state.

## BISBEE

Ninety miles southeast of Tucson, and situated in the Mule Mountains, **Bisbee**, is the picturesque county seat of historic Cochise County. The town was founded in 1880 as a mining community. Once known as the "Queen of the Copper Camps," this Old West mining camp proved to be one of the richest mineral sites in the world, producing nearly three million ounces of gold and more than eight billion pounds of copper.

By the early 1900's the Bisbee community was the largest city between St. Louis and San Francisco and had become one of the most cultured cities in the Southwest home to Arizona's first community library, a popular opera house, the state's oldest baseball field, and the state's first golf course.

When the mines closed, many artistic free spirits decided Bisbee was an ideal, attractive, and inexpensive location to settle in and pursue their artistic endeavors. Today, Bisbee has evolved into an attractive and welcoming artist and retirement community, known for its accepting and laid-back quality of life.

The happiest news is that up to 60% of Bisbee's population is LGBTQ. The entire town is incredibly accepting of everyone. There are no gay bars in Bisbee, but the bars that are there are welcoming to all, allowing you not to think twice if you choose to share a kiss with your partner.

## **TOMBSTONE**

Perhaps Arizona's most renowned town, "The town too tough to die," **Tombstone** is a step back into Arizona's Old West history. Shootings and other crimes got so bad in Tombstone in the 1880's that then-President of the U.S., Chester Arthur, declared martial law in Tombstone and sent in the troops! That was just

after the infamous shooting at the OK Corral in 1881 involving Wyatt Earp and Doc Holliday. You can see reenactments of that famous fight on a regular basis.

Residents of the city embrace their Old West history and have sought to preserve the historic old buildings and stories. The result is a unique look into America's past. The entire town of Tombstone is a true historic American landmark, and any lover of western memorabilia should definitely give Tombstone a visit.

#### BENSON

Nearby, Kartchner Caverns State Park features one of the world's best preserved "live" caves with one-of-akind formations and colors that aren't ordinarily seen in unpreserved caves. Check online for reservations. You can often book same-day tours.

## TUBAC

Another nice road trip to take while in the Tucson area is 50 miles south on Interstate 19 to **Tubac**. Established by the Spanish in 1752, Tubac is now a growing artist colony with over 80 galleries to browse and some of the state's best import shops.

The landscape is high desert with cottonwood and mesquite forests. Tubac boasts temperatures several degrees cooler than both Tucson and Phoenix in the summer months, making it a nice little getaway.

Try to see the Tumacacori Mission, established in 1691. Mountain bike enthusiasts should try the Elephant Head mountain biking trail. Beautiful Nogales, Arizona/Mexico is just a short drive south from Tubac. The authentic Mexican food and music are both worth a visit.



## Real Estate 101

## with Butch Leiber

## Q: How long have you been working as a real estate agent?

A: Agent experience is so important for clients to be well represented. I have been licensed for nearly twenty years and serve on our state association Professional Standards Committee and Diversity, Equity and Inclusion Committees. I also teach continuing education classes for REALTORS® and serve as President Elect for Phoenix REALTORS® and on the board of Arizona REALTORS®, the National Association of REALTORS® and Arizona Regional Multilisting Service.

#### What timeline can be expected for the buying process?

A: In today's low-inventory market, finding a home is taking more time than usual. But once a contract is negotiated - which could take a few days - the process from contract acceptance to getting the keys can take anywhere from 15 days (for a cash buyer) to 30 or 45 days for a lender with financing. The period from acceptance to "close" is called the escrow period and the length is negotiated in the purchase contract. The time required will depend on the buyer's and seller's needs, time for loan processing and other factors. Feel free to call with questions about your specific needs.

#### Q: What are the benefits of using an LGBTQ+ friendly real estate professional?

A. Every buyer and seller of real estate has unique needs. It's important for clients to feel comfortable and safe with their agent. Members of the LGBTO+ community often feel reluctant to share personal concerns or information with their agents if they don't feel their needs will be understood. For an agent to best represent their client, we need to really understand the clients' needs and wants, concerns and goals. When clients withhold information it makes it very hard to do our number one job: "protect and promote the best interests of the client" **INAR Code of Ethics Article 11** 

Working with an agent where you feel comfortable sharing is vital to a smooth and timely transaction. For many in the LGBTQ+ community, working with an agent who understands their unique needs is an important foundation to a successful transaction.



## Q: What is the first step in buying a home?

A: I bought my first house because my partner and I liked to visit open houses for fun. We fell in love with a house and boom - we were on our way. For most people though, planning ahead makes the process smoother. Start with consulting with a professional REALTOR® or mortgage lender. Figure out your budget and stick to it. Preplanning can help alleviate expensive emotional decisions. A skilled agent can help you organize a plan for success. Here's the risk of starting with looking at homes. Imagine finding the perfect home then learning you don't have the finances to afford. So you lower your aim and nothing you find compares to that first house. You're only setting yourself up for disappointment if you start with the house and not the plan.

## Q: How much is needed for a down payment?

A: The more a buyer can put down for a down payment the better. A higher down-payment can reduce the interest rate and save on the cost of mortgage insurance. However, buyers today have all kinds of choices. A military veteran may have availability of a VA Loan which requires zero money down. Depending on a buyer's creditworthiness, there are 3%. 5%, 10% and 20% down payment programs available. And, in most areas, there are downpayment assistance programs available for buyers in certain professions or buying in certain neighborhoods. Feel free to reach out to me or your real estate professional or mortgage lender to find out what's available for your situation.

### Q: Please explain the difference between a seller's market and a buyer's market?

A: For the better part of the last 8 vears in Arizona, we have been in a seller's market. That means there are more buyers looking to buy homes than sellers looking to sell. When DEMAND is higher than SUPPLY it becomes a seller's market. In a seller's market, the seller has the advantage. They don't have to spend as much to market or prepare a home to sell, they don't need to offer incentives to buyers, and they hold all the power. In a buyer's market, there is more SUPPLY than DEMAND. We haven't seen a buyer's advantage in a long time but in that market the buyer holds all the cards - sellers are often required to offer incentives to buyers to get their price - like help with closing costs, home warranties, etc.

In a balanced market, with normal supply and demand, we see prices remain flat or rise slowly - near the rate of inflation. In a seller's market, prices rise at a faster level. In 2021, property values in Phoenix rose close to 25%! Prices may fall in a buyer's market but it requires an extended time in a buyer's market to see prices drop. We typically see prices stay flat in most buyer's market.

## Q: Any recommendations for increasing a home's selling price?


A: Sellers have it easy in today's hot seller's market. With incredibly low inventory any house will sell. To increase the sales price of a home there are a few things a seller can do:


1. Put the property's best foot forward. A clean, tidy home will bring in a higher sales price (and potentially a better appraisal) than a house that is sloppy or dirty. Human beings are emotional beings so sellers who put in an effort to appeal to buyers' emotions often sell their homes for more. Fresh paint, colorful flowers, and a de-personalized home are inexpensive ways to increase a home's appeal. Fix the broken stuff you've been putting up with for years and start packing! Get rid of the clutter - box it up, put it in the garage or in storage, and make the house feel open and bright.

- 2. First impressions matter. Spending a little money on front landscaping, cleaning off the cobwebs in the entryway, and fixing the doorbell make an immediate first impression. Here's a little secret: if you tingle a buyer's senses while they're waiting for their agent to open the lockbox, they'll enter the house excited to see more. If they're looking at cracking paint or a dirty entryway they'll enter the house looking for more problems. Put them in a good mood and feed that mood.
- 3. Make your house available. Putting your home on the market then making it impossible to see is wasting everyone's time.
- 4. Hire an agent who knows how to market your home. Then trust your agent. We do this all the time and can help you position your house for the most money in the quickest amount of time or achieve whatever goal you're out to achieve.
